Adam moved, Kim seconded to approve the following consent agenda:

Minutes of Council Meeting on March 27, 2018  
Building Permits:

Kong Khamone – fence (this was tabled until the next meeting)

A roll call vote was taken: Kim – aye, Earl – aye, and Adam-aye. Approved three in favor, one absent. Kim moved, Adam seconded to table the building permit applied for by Kong Khamone until more information could be obtained for the next meeting. Approved three in favor, one absent.

There were several scouts in attendance that were working on their community communications badge. The Council discussed several city issues with them.

Kim moved, Adam seconded to approve the following business licenses:

Approved three in favor, one absent.

Mikel said Kim had asked him to do some research regarding an ATM machine or a card reader being installed at the pool so patrons could use a debit or credit card. He said a meeting is being held with a vendor to see what options the city might have. This will be discussed further at the next meeting.

Sandy said AIC will be holding their Spring Workshop on April 24, 2018 at the Hilton in Idaho Falls from 9 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. Earl, Adam and Sandy will be attending this workshop.

Kim moved, Adam seconded to approve a business license for 2018 for Hidden Treasures at 154 E. Center Street. This matter had been tabled at the last meeting. Approved three in favor, one absent.

Sandy presented some new figures to be used in calculating valuations for new residential building. She said the figures are based on the Idaho Falls valuation schedule. Kim moved, Adam seconded to table this until the next council meeting so Jeff could be present to review the information. Approved three in favor, one absent.

Sandy said there is new legislation that is effective July 1, 2018 regarding open meeting law. She said the agenda must now be posted at city hall, and posted on the city web site. Sandy said she is hoping they review this legislation further at the upcoming AIC Spring Workshop.

Sandy said there will be a Luau at Broulims this coming Saturday. She said they will be roasting a pig and selling meals. All proceeds will be given to the city for exercise equipment at Pillsbury Park.

Mikel said he will be drafting for baseball next week. He said they have starting draining the pool, and Pam would like to manage the pool again this summer.

Justin said "Spring Clean Up" will be held from April 23<sup>rd</sup> to the 27<sup>th</sup>. He said the Water Tank Project is going well. He said they poured the pad today, and the contractor is doing a great job. Justin said Well #1 has been put back on line and into the city distribution system. He said the testing came back good, and all wells are running great.

Justin said the new meters have been installed on Wells #1 and #5. He said Well #3 will have the newly required meter installed soon, and Well #4 will have the required meter when the Water Project is done.


Justin said he has not received any complaints regarding the new garbage schedule that will be in effect as of April 30, 2018. He said there have been a few questions though. Sandy said she has not received any complaints either. She thanked Justin and the crew for helping with high lighting the new garbage schedule information that was on the billing for April 1<sup>st</sup>.

Kim said Dayle Searle received some trees that have been donated to the city. She will be storing them until they can be planted.

Kim said she sat on the Scholarship Selection Committee and there are nine Shelley kids that will receive awards this year.

Earl thanked everyone for all of their efforts and the work being done.
