Mayor Pascoe opened the meeting at 7:31 p.m.

Kim moved, Jeff seconded to approve the following consent agenda:

Approval of July 22, 2014 Council Meeting Minutes Approval of August 6, 2014 Work Meeting Minutes Building Permits: Jamie Petersen - deck Michael Woolf - fence Betty Carson - fence O'Reiley Auto Parts - new building Bateman Hall Const. - addition/remodel

Roll Call Vote: Jeff - aye, Adam - aye, Earl - aye, and Kim - aye. Approved unanimously.

Sandy presented the Tentative Budget for the fiscal year 2014-2015 in the amount of \$9,378,021. She presented the publication and the narrative for the Mayor and Council's review. The Mayor and Council looked at the publication and discussed a proposed COL raise for the employees. Earl said he is concerned about the cost of health care and how large of an increase in premiums that we may see. He said he is not in favor of granting a COL increase at this time. Jeff said that the city saved about \$65,000 from the decrease that we received in January. He said even with a 20% increase we will still see a savings of \$38,000 from the previous year. Jeff felt the city should give the employees a 1% COL raise. Kim said she understands everyone's view points, but wants to be cautious about this, and would have to vote no for a COL increase at this time. Adam said he has reviewed the budget and he feels the budget numbers look good and the employees are doing great. He said he feels the city should give a 1% COL raise. The Mayor and Council determined this will be reviewed again and make a decision at the budget hearing. The proposed fee increases include swimming lessons being raised by \$5, pool reservation fees being increased by \$25, park shelter reservation fee being increased by \$10, and monthly sewer fees being increased by \$.70. Jeff moved, Earl seconded to adopt the tentative budget for fiscal year 2014-2015 as presented and authorized Sandy to publish it to notify the public that a budget hearing will be held September 3, 2014, at 7:30 p.m. at the Shelley City Hall. Approved unanimously. A copy of the tentative budget is attached.

Sandy presented the Tentative Budget for the Urban Renewal District for fiscal year 2014-2015 in the amount of \$951,283. Adam moved, Jeff seconded to adopt the Tentative Budget for fiscal year 2014-2015 and authorized Sandy to publish it to notify the public that a budget hearing will be held September 3, 2014 at 7:30 p.m. at the Shelley City Hall. Approved unanimously. A copy of the tentative budget is attached.

Rod discussed the position of the SRO and recommended that a current reserve officer, Mark Evans be hired for this position. Rod gave the Mayor and Council members a copy of Mr. Evans biography. He said Mr. Evans has been a reserve officer since 2008, and is great dealing with the public. Earl moved, Kim seconded to give Mr. Mark Evans a letter of intent to hire him at an entry level wage with a six month probationary period conditional upon the results of a polygraph and psychiatric evaluation. Approved unanimously.

Adam moved, Earl seconded to transfer \$176,000 from the LID fund to the Streets fund to be appropriated for street replacement and repair. Approved unanimously.

Jeff moved, Kim seconded to approve the following business licenses for 2014: Hard Times Sales and Distribution - 646 S. State Street. CJ's Snow Shack (Itinerant License) - 530 N. State Street Approved unanimously.

Dave Noel said they should be doing pressure testing on the North Water Line Loop Project sometime next week.

Dawn said the Jazz Clinic was held today. She said they had quite a large crowd.

Dawn said the Grid Kid Football program does not have enough fields to play on, and asked if they could come from Idaho Falls and use the city's fields on Saturdays. Dawn said if we allow them to use our fields she would like to recommend that we charge them at least \$25 to cover the paint to mark the fields and the maintenance involved. The Mayor and Council agreed. Dawn will talk to the Grid Kid Association more about it and report back to the Council.

Chuck said he contacted ITD about the crossing lights, but had to leave a message. He has not heard any response yet.

Rod said school will be starting soon and he would like to ask everyone to drive more cautiously.

Adam said he talked to Sandy about creating an app for the city. He said he is trying to put one together and will be looking at Pay Pal for city utility and recreation program payment options. Adam said he will continue working on this project, but will need to pay \$250 to the company to get it started.

Kim said Kay Gneiting will be having a meeting on August 21, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. to discuss the walk path. This meeting will be held at City Hall.

Kim said the Tree Committee will be meeting and will begin looking for a yard that would be awarded "Yard of the Year".

Jeff asked abut the railroad approach and widening it. Chuck said he has not heard anything yet from Union Pacific. Jeff discussed putting together a letter for the railroad regarding the crossing for the future connector road.

Mayor Pascoe asked what type of response the city has received in regards to interest in a curb side recycling service. Sandy said so far there has only been thirteen residents express interest, but she will make sure the information is put on the billing again next month.
