Jeff moved, Earl seconded to approve the following consent agenda:

Roll Call Vote: Jeff – aye, Adam – aye, Earl – aye, and Kim aye. Approved unanimously.

Mayor Pascoe presented a plaque expressing the city's appreciation to Bruce Rudd for his service to the community as a member of the Planning and Zoning Commission for the past six years.

Calvin Horch of Guardian Homes addressed the Council to request access to city water service outside of the city limits at 1233 N. 915 E. in the Willow Estates Subdivision. Sandy said the subdivision was platted when the city had jurisdiction in the Impact Area, and it was platted with city water servicing it. She said the responsibility of the owner is to place their own water meter, sign an outside service contract, pay the connection fees, and sign a consent to annex when annexable. Mr. Horch said the location they are constructing the home is Lot 5 in Block 2 of the Willow Estate Subdivision. Jeff moved, Kim seconded to allow access of city water to Lot 5, Block 2 in the Willow Estates Subdivision. Approved unanimously.

Bobby Stewart, 458 Cardinal addressed the Mayor and Council as a concerned citizen, husband, and father. He said he wanted to discuss the language of the National Defense Authorization Act which has brought war onto our soil. Mr. Stewart said basically the ambiguity of this type of wording has any belligerent, hostile person according to section 10-21 and 10-22 can be sweep up in the middle of the night by the government. He said the City of Emmett passed a law that prohibits federal government from this act. Mr. Stewart presented some packets of information to the Mayor and Council and discussed the contents in regards to the City of Emmett and contact information about the ordinance they passed. Mr. Stewart said America has changed. He said legislation has come up with some very good laws that prohibit the commandeering of local police, etc. He wanted to introduce himself and let the City know what he stands for. Mr. Stewart said he has an eleven year old daughter and picked Shelley to raise his family. Jeff

asked if Emmett has ever had to enforce this law. Mr. Stewart said no, they haven't and he doesn't think the likely hood will ever happen but it is still a good line to draw in the sand.

Earl moved, Kim seconded to approve the attached list of business license application to be renewed for 2014. Approved unanimously.

Sandy presented an updated contact sheet to the Mayor and Council with various contact information for P&Z, Tree Committee, Urban Renewal Commission, etc.

Sandy presented the Building Permit Report for 2013. She said building is down from last year, however the additional valuation is about the same due to the commercial building.

Sandy said she was contact by Jay Shore of the television program "Communities of Distinction" regarding the possibility of using the City of Shelley for a "Place to Call Home" segment of their show. The segment would be aired twenty times, once nationally. The scheduling fee for our city is \$19,800. Sandy said this amount is not budgeted for this fiscal year. The Mayor and Council determined this expense would not benefit the community. Sandy will contact Mr. Shore and let him know.

Kim asked about the recycling bin that was going to be placed in the city. Sandy said the bin has been placed at Broulims in their parking lot and will cost the city \$81 per month. Sandy said Shirley will be doing a story in the Pioneer to educate the public that there are bins in the city and what can be placed in those bins.


Jeff said he was unable to attend the meeting with DEQ personnel. He said he is disappointed in the response from DEQ regarding reuse water and recharge water. Jeff said he intends to pursue the possibility of getting water rights for recharging the aquifer with water from the treatment plant.

Earl asked if there are any curb side recycling companies that service the city. Adam said he uses Earthwise Recycling. Stacy said he will follow up with the owner to see if more citizens could utilize the program.

Stacy said he attended a meeting in Pocatello regarding the gas tax the city received a portion of from the State. He said in 2002 the city received \$152,000 and in 2012 it received \$145,000 in revenue from the State. He said during this time the buying power was down by \$79,000. Stacy said for every \$1 not spent to maintain a street in the city, we will spend \$7 to \$9 to fix it in the future. He said the State Highway User is the main source of revenue in the Street Funds. He said property tax supplements this fund. Stacy said the city is doing great, and everyone is working well together.
