Roll Call Vote: Jeff – aye, Adam – aye, Earl – aye, and Kim was absent. Approved three in favor, one absent.

Earl moved, Adam seconded to approve the attached list of business licenses for 2014. Approved three in favor, one absent.

Dave said the ozone system has been installed at the lift station at the wastewater treatment plant. He said the equipment that was installed is temporary, until the equipment we ordered comes in sometime in March. He said this should alleviate any odor complaints.

Chuck said the Kiwanis donated \$1000 to the city for Christmas lights.

Rod said Bevanda, the local coffee shop closed its doors last Friday. He said Heather Bowcutt, the owner closed due to not having enough business.

Adam said he talked to Chad Christensen, the owner of Earthwise Recycling. He said Mr. Christensen indicated that the national average for recyclable material is 75%. Adam said he talked to Chuck about ways that recycling could be handled. Possibly we could provide recycling for a few neighborhoods on a trial basis. Jeff suggested eventually incorporating recycling into the city pick up and possibly charging those who do not participate more, but this would be further down the road. Stacy suggested promoting recycling first, and informing people about the various recycling companies. Jeff said we need to show residents that we're looking at the economics of recycling. Mayor Pascoe suggested moving forward with the recycling bins and promoting recycling. He said the bins are full right now and we may possibly

need a second bin, or the first bin to be picked up more frequently. He said we will watch this over time.

Dave said the surveyor is proofing the easements for the water line loop. He said once this is done it can be recorded so the design could be done.

Mayor Pascoe said he visited the treatment plant and the ozone system seems to be working fine. He said they are currently using a pilot system.
