Kim moved, Adam seconded to approve the following consent agenda: Minutes of September 27, 2016

A roll call vote was taken: Earl - aye, Kim - aye, Jeff - aye, and Adam-aye. Approved unanimously.

Melinda Norris from the Idaho Rural Water Association gave a presentation regarding a Source Water Protection Plan. She said she is available to help the city implement this plan at no cost to the city. She said IRWA is a non-profit organization and is a State affiliate of the National Rural Water Association. Ms. Norris said she assists public water systems throughout the State to develop a SWPP. She said the plan to help protect our city's water and the aquifer. She said our aquifer is a sole source. Ms. Norris said the Plan is not mandated in Idaho, however most municipalities will need to present a plan for any USDA grant funding. She said this plan will help educate the public of the importance of protecting our water. Ms. Norris said 98% of the plan is to create public awareness and to educate people. Again she said there is no cost to the city for her to help develop this plan. The Council members asked a few questions regarding the benefit of this plan. Justin felt the plan would be good to have. The Council also felt this will be a good project for the city. Ms. Norris said a Committee will need to be appointed. Jeff moved, Kim seconded to move forward with an IRWA Agreement for the development of a source water protection plan. Approved unanimously.

Mayor Pascoe asked BJ to conduct the public hearing regarding the acceptance of the Water Study. Dave presented the water study, and discussed the three alternatives to work towards to fixing our deficiencies. The final recommendation was the third alternative which is to complete the improvements in three phases: replace the water tank with an 800,000 gallon tank - \$1,402,000 in phase one. In phase two to increase the size of the line from Well #5 and to upsize the pump -

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\$108,570. In phase three to redevelop Well #4 at \$455,430. The total cost of improvements is \$1,966,000. Dave discussed possible funding sources. He said if the URA could contribute \$600,000, a CBG grant - \$500,000, a loan for \$765,000, and the city - \$100,000. He said the rates would need to be increased by \$2 per month to pay for the funding. Dave said the city could raise the rates over a period of time to come up with the funding if necessary. BJ asked for if there were any comments from the public in favor, opposition or neutral comments. There was no public testimony given and the public hearing was closed. Jeff moved, Earl seconded to accept the study as presented by Dave Noel. Earl – aye, Jeff – aye, Adam – aye, and Kim – aye. Approved unanimously. Dave said when we begin to pursue grants USDA will require a little bit different study, and A CBG grant will required an environmental document with the study.

Sandy said Bingham County Planning and Zoning sent a comment sheet for a public hearing for Jim Cook to rezone his property form RA to A and to do a two lot subdivision. His property is located next to the river. The Mayor and Council had no concerns or comments regarding this matter.

Sandy said whereas Beth is retiring she has requested to have an open house during normal business hours rather than having one in the evening. Sandy suggested her last day which is October 31st, having an open house from noon to 5:00 p.m. The Mayor and Council agreed.

Scott Williams has given his resignation effective November 4, 2016. The Council recommended to begin taking applications for his position immediately through October 28th.

Adam moved, Kim seconded to donate a season pass from the swimming pool to the North Bingham County Library. The pass may be checked out and used by a family once per season. Approved unanimously.

Sandy said our connection fee for a Fire Suppression Line is \$500. She said when Justin was completing the last Fire Suppression Line the cost was closer to \$1850. The typical size line for fire suppression is six inch. The Mayor and Council called for a public hearing to increase the fee for a fire suppression line to \$1850. A public hearing will be held on this matter on November 8, 2016.

Sandy said all is going well in City Hall. She said the new employee is training with Beth and doing great.

Justin said they started Fall Clean Up today. He said the crew has been working on winterization, etc.

Mayor Pascoe said Earl attended the signing of the proclamation for the Domestic Violence Vigil. He said the Vigil will be held Thursday night at the City Park at 6:00 p.m.
