Charlotte moved, Earl seconded to approve the following consent agenda:

A roll call vote was called for: Earl – aye, Charlotte – aye, and John - aye. Approved three in favor, one absent.

Mike Carter discussed additional street lights being installed along the walking path when it is reconstructed. He said Rocky Mountain Power may be able to participate in funding for solar or LED lighting (energy saving). Mr. Carter said a written proposal will need to be submitted to the company for consideration. He recommended choosing a generic style of light and pole so future lights can be matched when installed later. John asked Chuck if he would help him contact the city engineers regarding this matter.

Earl moved, John seconded to approve the following business licenses for 2010:

Approved three in favor, one absent.

Sandy presented a comment sheet from Bingham County Planning and Zoning regarding a rezone for the Hunter residence on 800 East. The Mayor and Council had no comments or concerns regarding this rezone application.

Rick said he talked to Chris at Basic American Foods regarding the noise complaint that was received by the city due to the new steam stacks that are being installed at the business. He said Chris stated that they are having the same issue at the Rexburg plant and are working on the

problem. John said Dwayne Gotch has had experience in this type of problem and may be able to offer some solutions. Rick said he will pass the information along to Bruce Crockett.

BJ said he is working on a collection for city property damage (storm sewer on State Street) during a construction project. He said the State of Idaho is going to reimburse the city for the damage repair.

Sandy asked who would be attending the AIC conference in Idaho Falls this year. Each council member should have received a conference brochure.

Sandy said the paving and curbing at the wastewater treatment plant is scheduled to be done during Segment B of the Eastern Interceptor project. She said the Board would like the paving and curbing done prior to the open house and AIC tour which will be held June 16, 2010. The approximate cost of the project is \$40,000, and the engineer asked if the City of Shelley could pay for the expense and be reimbursed by the project before the end of the fiscal year. Sandy said Bingham County and the City of Shelley is undertaking the project so it can be finished by the open house. The Council granted permission to expend approximately \$40,000 and then be reimbursed by the Eastern Interceptor Segment B Project before the end of the year.

Rick said he received three bids for lining the sewer line on Seminary Avenue and South Park. He said the work will probably not be able to be done until October. Rick said the low bid received was \$34,760 from Insituform. The council asked Rick to make sure that freight was included in the bid.

Mike Carter, the Fire Chief wanted to discuss a problem in the city and would like the Council's support. He said Hidden Treasures on South Emerson is a fire hazard. He said there are some issues regarding exit capability, and they would only be able to fight fires from the outside only during non-operating hours. He said during operating hours there may be people to get out of the building during a fire and this would be a hazard to the fire personnel. Mike said he has some Fire Inspectors scheduled to look at the facility. He would like the council's support that the building should be brought up to fire standards. Mayor Christensen said he and the Council would do what is necessary to provide safety in this community, and will support the Fire Department.

Charlotte said there was a Tree Committee meeting tonight. Arbor Day is scheduled for May 22, 2010, and she invited all to attend.

John discussed filling Rick's vacancy as Public Works Director. He said the city policy currently states that openings will be offered in house, and then if nobody is qualified then the position will be advertised. John discussed the importance for consistency, and suggested to offer this position for two weeks and then if it is not filled, then advertise the position for two weeks. Earl suggested trying to keep open positions like this one in house for advancement purposes. John agreed.

Mayor Christensen said last Thursday he attended the bid opening for Segment B of the Eastern Interceptor sewer line. He said the low bid was submitted by H-K in the amount of \$7,384,567.00. Mayor Christensen said this is almost one million dollars under the engineers estimate.
