The Mayor called the meeting to order at 7:35p.m.

Justin Johnson led the Pledge of Allegiance and Adam French gave the invocation.

Earl moved to accept the following items on the Consent Agenda:

- Adam seconded the motion. Earl -aye; Jeff -aye; Kim -aye; and Adam -aye. The consent agenda was approved unanimously

Mike Spencer Location Coordinator for Wreaths Across America invited the council on December 15, 2018 at the Hillcrest Cemetery at 10 a.m. Nalder's Funeral Home is providing a canopy for observers. Local Boy Scout Troops under the direction of Floyd Ross will perform colors. Members of David B. Bleak Post 93 of the American Legion will present the wreaths for each of the armed service and the POW/MIA. The national ceremony will be held noon Eastern Time at Arlington National Cemetery.

Kerri Winder, 1004 W Fir St is disputing being charged for 2 ERU's sewer fee's since there are two adults and two children living in the home. She is operating a pre-school with seven children enrolled and she does not feel they are using that much sewer to justify being charged 2 ERU's. Jeff addressed that the City of Shelley has a joint agreement with EIRWVA stating that any single family home will be charged 2 ERU's if operating a daycare, preschool or beauty salon in the home. Kerri stated she reached out to the City of Ammon and they notified her that they do

not charge an additional ERU for operating a pre-school in a home. Jeff mentioned that finding out that the City of Ammon is not abiding by the joint agreement will be brought to the attention of the EIRWWA Board. Ms. Winder asked that in the summer months when she is not operating the pre-school would she only be charged for 1 ERU. Jeff will verify with the EIRWWA board and we will get in contact with her in December.

Lani Roach of ALR Properties was not in attendance.

Justin Johnson said that former employee Chuck Lloyd was interested in purchasing the old diesel Toro riding mower to mow the pasture behind his home. Justin thinks it's worth \$300 to \$500. Adam made a motion to sell the 1997 Toro riding mower for \$300 to Chuck Lloyd. Kim seconded the motion and it was passed with 4 ayes.

Consider canceling Council meeting on December 25th and November 27th 2018.

Jeff made a motion to cancel December 25th council meeting and the November 27, 2018 meeting with the condition that nothing is on agenda five days prior to the meeting. Kim seconded it and the vote was 4 ayes.

The Stash, a clothing Boutique is requesting a business license. Kim made a motion to approve the business license for The Stash. Jeff seconded it and the vote was 4 ayes.

Jeff asked to remove the item on the agenda to Discuss Viability of Action against DEQ/Standards for Rapid Infiltration until further notice.

BJ Report that Sandy received an electronic copy of the development agreement for All Star homes late this afternoon he will review it.

Justin Johnson reported they have finished fall clean up and they have begun putting up Christmas lights. The Hawk light delivery date has been pushed back. The new water tank samples came positive for coliform so they will be sanitizing the tank again and draining it out.

Rod Mohler invited the council to a small active shooter training at that the High School. They are helping a student with their senior project. Those who wish to attend will be with the chief the entire time.
