CHAPTER 6

PROVISIONS FOR OFFICIAL CITY MAPS

10-6-2:	Interpretation of District Boundaries
10-6-3:	Designated Arterials and Collectors
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Official Zoning Map

10-6-1: OFFICIAL ZONING MAP: The boundaries of the use districts established in 10-5 (Establishment and Purpose of Districts) of this Ordinance are shown on the Official Zoning Map of the City of Shelley which is adopted as part of this Ordinance (see Exhibit A).

10-6-2: INTERPRETATION OF DISTRICT BOUNDARIES: Where uncertainty exists with respect to the boundaries of any of the use districts as shown on the Official Zoning Map, the following shall apply:

- (A) Where district boundaries are indicated as approximate following the center line of streets, highway right-of-way, streams, canals or other bodies of water, the center line shall be construed to be such boundary.
- (B) Where district boundaries are indicated as approximately following lot lines, such lot lines shall be construed to be said boundaries.
- (C) Where district boundaries are so indicated that they are approximately parallel to the center lines or street lines of streets or the center lines or right-of-way lines of highways, such district boundaries shall be construed as being parallel thereto and at such distance therefrom as indicated on the Official Zoning Map. If no such distance is given, such dimensions shall be determined by the use of the scale shown on the Official Zoning Map.
- (D) Where the boundary of a district follows a railroad line, such boundary shall be deemed to be located in the middle of the main tracks of said railroad line.
- 10-6-3: DESIGNATED ARTERIALS AND COLLECTORS: The arterials, collectors and streets of the City are indicated on the Official Arterial and Street Map which is adopted as part of this Ordinance (see Exhibit B).

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
