**Building Permits:** 

A roll call vote was called for: Stacy – aye, Jeff – aye, Kurt – aye, and Earl – aye. Approved unanimously.

Andrea Jo Jolley, the President of the Mayor's Youth Committee said they will be providing Christmas entertainment at the Gables Assisted Living Center on December 17<sup>th</sup>. She said they also helped with the Chili Cook Off which was a great success. Andrea thanked those that sponsored their sweatshirts. She said it is a great help when they can wear something that represents their club. Andrea said they are working on a recycling project and a smile project. She said they also have a lunch buddy program with the students at Hobbs Middle School every Thursday.

Jacob Lundquist, the Real Estate Agent for Fall Creek Homes said they have a lot in the Willow Estates Subdivision that they purchased. He said they are building a home on the lot and would like to connect to city water. Sandy said when the original plat was approved, the Willow Estates Subdivision was within our jurisdiction and was approved accessing city water. She said the property owners still need to seek permission from the city to connect to the water, and then sign a users agreement and a consent to annex. Jeff moved, Kurt seconded to allow the property owner at 1235 N. 915 E. Shelley, to connect to city water upon signing the consent for annexation, user agreement, purchase of a meter, pay the connection fees, etc. Approved unanimously.

Kurt moved, Stacy seconded to approve a Beer License/Carry Out Only for Shelley Main Street Exxon for 2013. Approved unanimously.

Jeff moved, Stacy seconded to approve the attached business licenses submitted on November 27, 2012, as presented for 2012. Approved unanimously.

Rod said he has fourteen bicycles/scooters that have been found or never claimed in a case, that he would like to have declared surplus property. He said he would like to donate these bicycles to Bill's Bike Shop who in turn refurbishes the bicycles to give to those children less fortunate at Christmas time. Rod said these bicycles/scooters have been held by the department for over a year. Sandy said Mel Middleton was interested in locating an animal crematorium in the city. She said after the Council discussed it several meetings ago she invited Ms. Middleton into a council meeting to discuss her seriousness of opening this type of business in Shelley. Sandy said Ms. Middleton was going to discuss matters with her bank and then get back to her. She said she has not had any response back from Ms. Middleton yet.

Sandy said historically the city office has closed at noon on Christmas Eve day and held a luncheon for the city employees. The Mayor and Council concurred that it would be okay to close at noon this year also.

Dawn said she has thirty teams drafted for Basketball so far.

Chuck said he met with the Public Works Director of Menan who would like to purchase the city's six aerators that had been left from the lagoon operation. Chuck said these aerators were already declared as surplus property some time ago. Sandy said since this property is going to another public entity bids were not needed, however it would require a motion from the council. Chuck said Menan has made an offer of \$500 for all six aerators which he feels is very fair. The Council agreed that the city should sell the aerators to Menan and this matter would be placed on the next agenda to be ratified.

Chuck said the well drillers have approximately twenty five more feet to go, and then they can start pulling the pipes. He said hopefully they will be done in about a week.

Rod said he will be participating in "Shop with a Cop" in Blackfoot on December 8<sup>th</sup>. He said this is a very fun time, and will be held at the Blackfoot Walmart.

Jeff said the Christmas lights look great in the city. He thanked Chuck and his crew.

Stacy echoed Jeff's comments on the city's appearance as did Kurt and Jeff.

Stacy said Officer Lewis is attending training in Las Vegas this week. He said he is concerned if Officer Lewis will come back and train the other officers in the Department with what he learned at this training. Rod said yes, during the monthly training meetings, any officer who has attended special training will train the other officers.

Mayor Christensen said there will be an EIRWWA meeting on December 12, 2012 at 9:00 a.m. at the Shelley City Hall.

Mayor Christensen commented on the Tree Light Ceremony and how great the City Park looks.
